³ **Bursary application requirements and bursary conditions:**

Submission of a **letter of recommendation** from the bursary applicant's **current workplace or from the leadership of the local ILAE Chapter or Regional Commission** stating the expected benefit to the epilepsy care and development in the bursary applicant's community **is required**. In case such evidence cannot be submitted, a **personal letter of motivation** is required outlining the benefit the bursary candidate expects for his/her daily practice and professional career **specific to the Level 1 courses** for which application is being made. Please note that this requirement (letter of recommendation OR personal letter of motivation) is **mandatory** and is an important part of the decision-making process for the granting of any bursary. It is also important to note that no progress and completion of the compulsory courses within 1 year impacts future decisions about bursary eligibility. Bursaries will be **partial bursaries** involving partial payment. **Partial bursaries will only be available for participants living in countries with low and lower middle income. There are no further discounts available if a bursary is awarded.**
